- ✓ On **May 19, 2020**, CABEI and the Ministry of Economy and Finance (MoEF) of the Republic of Korea signed an Agreement for **the creation of the Korea-CABEI Partnership Single Donor Trust Fund (KTF)**.
- ✓ The KTF provides non-reimbursable resources contributed by MoEF for the identification and preparation of projects that incorporate Korean content, technologies and solutions in various sectors.
- ✓ Its objective is to harness the experience and development expertise of the Republic of Korea to promote the adoption and use of innovative technologies and solutions for Bank-executed activities.
- ✓ On **August 12, 2020**, the Fund received the **Initial Fund Contribution** from MoEF.

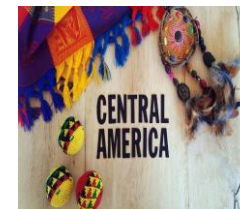

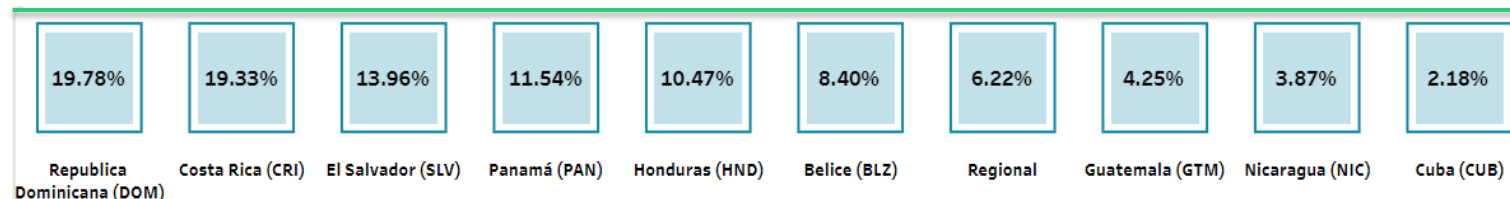

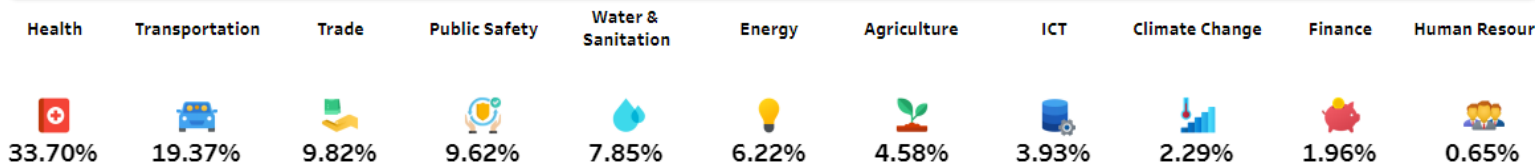

Technical Cooperations (1/7)

1. Republic of Korea's In-kind Contribution to Support Central America's Response to COVID-19



Provide in-kind assistance to member countries of CABEI to offer substantive support to their COVID-19 response efforts and aim to contribute to contain its transmission.

3. Establishment of a Biotech manufacturing cluster to increase accessibility and affordability of healthcare and medical equipment in Central America



Support the Bank implement a strategy to attract South Korean Bio-Technology firms within the healthcare, medical equipment, services and manufacturing sectors to form a biotechnology cluster in a member country.

2. Support for the development of the Pacific Train in El Salvador



Support the Government of El Salvador (GOES) explore the viability of the Pacific Train & Rail network for cargo and possibly passenger transport.

4. Integration of Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) in CA



Help identify and create an enabling environment that can enhance power system flexibility through Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS) applied to the electric systems in the region.

Technical Cooperations (2/7)

5. KorBCIE-Diagnosis and Accompaniment for the Channeling of Resources from Institutional Investors from the Republic of Korea to Central America



Develop an investment structure that will serve as a vehicle to channel capital to Central American countries from South Korean institutional investors who have the intention and desire to invest in the region.

7. Support natural disaster redevelopment efforts incorporating climate adaption measures



Strengthen CABEI's capacity to support the countries that have been impacted by the devastating effects of climate change, in particular natural disasters.

6. Regional Investment Fund



The establishment of a fund that will register and list in the Panamanian capital markets and invest in locally issued sovereign and corporate debt denominated in US Dollars.

8. Wastewater treatment facility and sewage system in Liberia, Costa Rica



Support the Government of Costa Rica (GOCR) develop feasibility studies to modernize and expand the existing wastewater treatment facility and sewage systems in Liberia.

Technical Cooperations (3/7)

9. Development of Panama Metro Line 5 Rail Network



Conduct a feasibility study for the development of Panama City's Line 5 metro rail network, as well as strengthen the institutional capacity of its operator, Metro de Panama S.A

10. Development of a Trade Repository for the cross-border clearing and settlement of sovereign securities for Central America



Support the development for a Central America Trade Repository (TR) that will enable the cross-border clearing and settlement of sovereign and corporate securities.

11. South Korean-CABEI Cultural Exchange Program



Engage in a cultural exchange during the Board of Governor's Meeting by showcasing of traditional Korean cuisine and South Korean heritage demonstrations and traditional performances

12. Leveraging technologies to support the Government of Costa Rica with the development of a climate-smart greenhouse



Deployment of a climate-smart greenhouse pilot project for the purpose of research and development (R&D) and increase food supply to domestic and international markets, South Korea in particular.

Technical Cooperations (4/7)

13. Development of the Santiago de los Caballeros - Santo Domingo Rail Line



Evaluate the integration and connectivity of the Dominican Republic's two most populous and productive cities, Santiago de los Caballeros ("Santiago") and Santo Domingo and link these two urban areas with La Haina Port.

15. Supporting the Internationalization platform for SICA Firms under the Free Trade Agreement between the Republic of South Korea and Central America



Increase trade and investment flows between the Republic of Korea (ROK) and Central America (CA) through the development of a comprehensive internationalization program under the Free Trade Agreement (FTA) between ROK and Central American countries (K-CAFTA).

14. Modernization of La Ceiba Port through Waterfront Development



Provide a roadmap for the redevelopment of La Ceiba Port and highlight focused investment in port infrastructural development to facilitate commerce while maintaining ecosystem for tourism.

16. Strengthening CABEI's and the Government of Honduras' Institutional Competitiveness by advancing their Human Resources Management & Governance



Assess and modernize the Bank's current policies and practices for Human Resource Management (HRM), via transfer knowledge and feasible solutions that enhance the Bank's institutional capacity.

Technical Cooperations (5/7)

17. Building Offshore Wind Capacity in Costa Rica



Support the assessment of the field data base and environmental conditions in the North Pacific Coast of Costa Rica as well as recommend necessary investments for marine-coastal infrastructure that would enable the development of offshore wind power.

19. Modernization of Hospitals and Healthcare Services in Belize



Modernize healthcare infrastructure and reinforce institutional, technical, and operational capacities of hospital administrators and physicians to create the necessary conditions to have Belize become a leading medical tourism destination in Latin America.

18. Modernization of the Dominican Republic Customs Management System



Conduct a comprehensive review and analysis of the Dominican Republic's (DR) customs management system and develop a strategic roadmap for modernization of its information and communications technology (ICT) infrastructure.

20. Support CABEI ROK Free Trade Conference in Seoul, South Korea



Support the execution of activities in Seoul, South Korea related to the CABEI ROK Free Trade Conference to promote trade and investment between South Korea and Central America

Technical Cooperations (6/7)

21. Modernization of the Guluchapa Water Supply System in San Salvador through dedicated Photovoltaic (PV) generation and Integrated Water Resource Management



Support the modernization of the Guluchapa water supply system and its infrastructure by developing an independent energy generation plant and leveraging information and communication technologies (ICT) to enhance their operational efficiency and mitigate water loss.

23. Integration of the Public Bus & Metro Systems in West Panama Province



Develop a strategy for the restructuring of the public bus system in the Panama Metropolitan Area in the districts of Arraiján and La Chorrera within West Panama Province.

22. Intelligent Traffic Systems in Santo Domingo and the National Highways of the Dominican Republic



Study the feasibility of deploying an Intelligent Traffic System (ITS) within the city of Santo Domingo and across the national highway system of the Dominican Republic (DR).

24. Coffee Cooperation between CABEI and the Republic of Korea



Promote specialty coffee produced in Central America (CA) and develop business relations between CA coffee exporters and ROK coffee importers, associations, and cooperatives.

Technical Cooperations (7/7)

25. Prefeasibility Study for the National Autonomous University of Honduras's Medical Campus in Tegucigalpa and San Pedro Sula



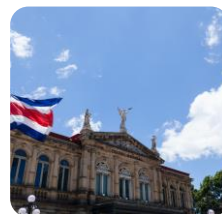
Support the development of a modern university medical campus in Tegucigalpa and San Pedro Sula to improve the quality of healthcare services and education in the country.

27. Modernization of Bus Transport Network in San Salvador



Modernize the urban bus transport system of San Salvador, the capital of El Salvador, through an overhaul of the existing bus system.

26. Pre-Investment Plans for the Development and Modernization of Nationwide Fire Stations and Deployment of a Fire Detection Drone Pilot in Costa Rica



Determine the appropriate investments and interventions necessary related to infrastructure, equipment, management systems; as well as demonstrate South Korea's cutting-edge technologies to strengthen firefighting capabilities and expand coverage.

28. Deployment of an Integrated Public Safety Platform (IPSP) Pilot in the province of Santiago, Dominican Republic



Develop a pilot initiative to establish an Integrated Public Safety Platform deploying security technologies within the province of Santiago.
